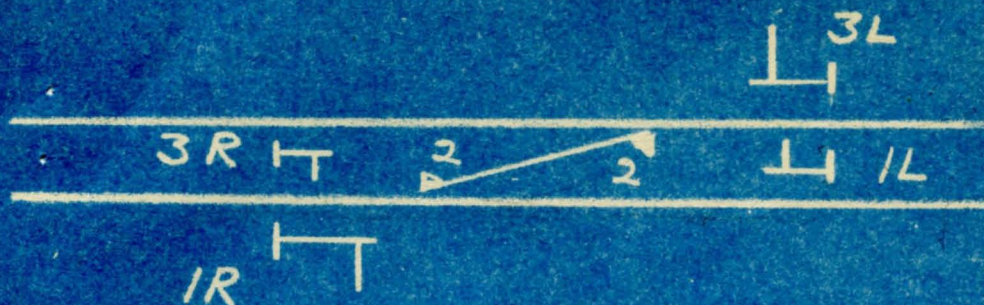
This is in accordance with Mr. Thomas' letter of August 12th, file 1346-1348, a copy of which you received.

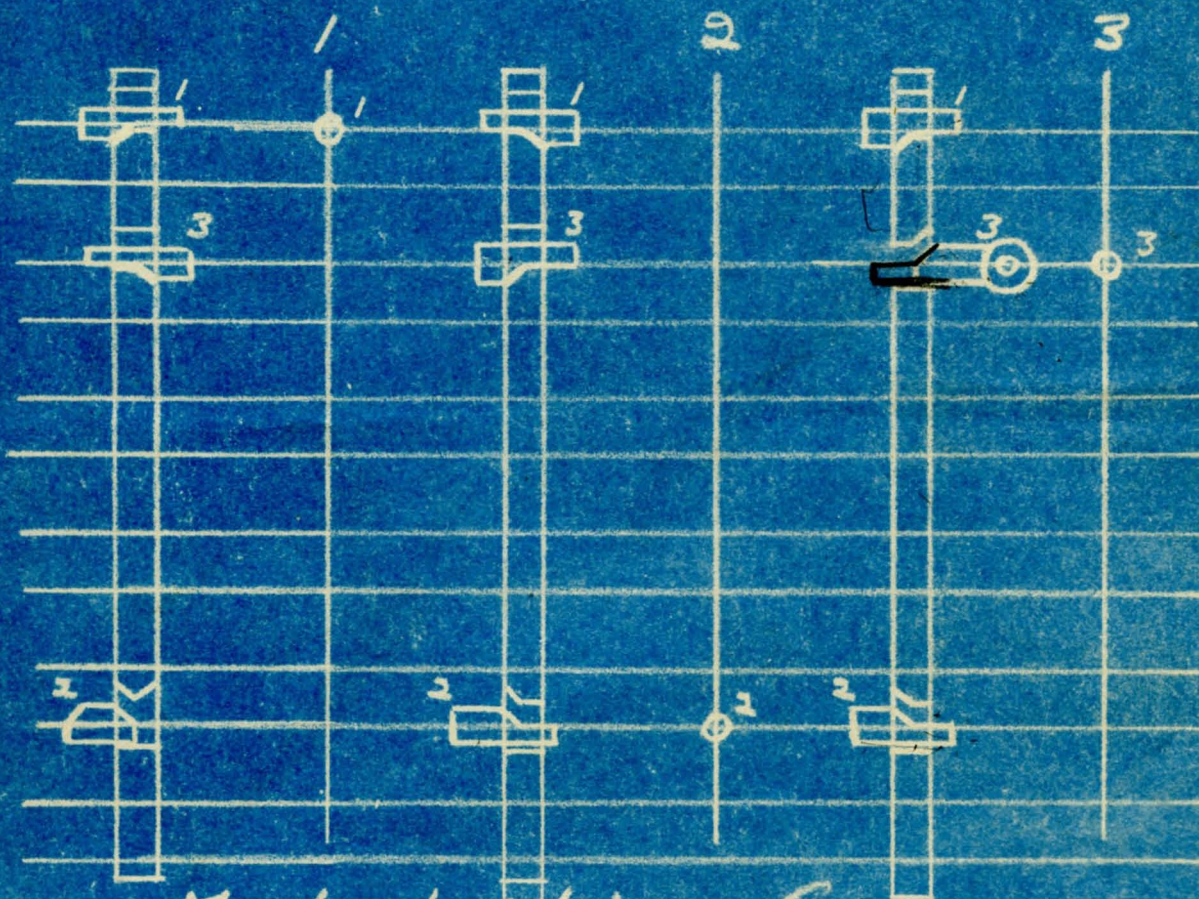

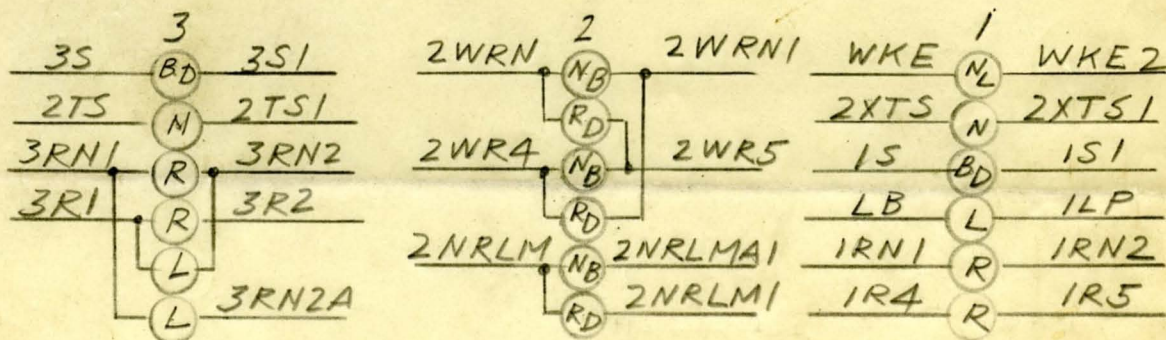
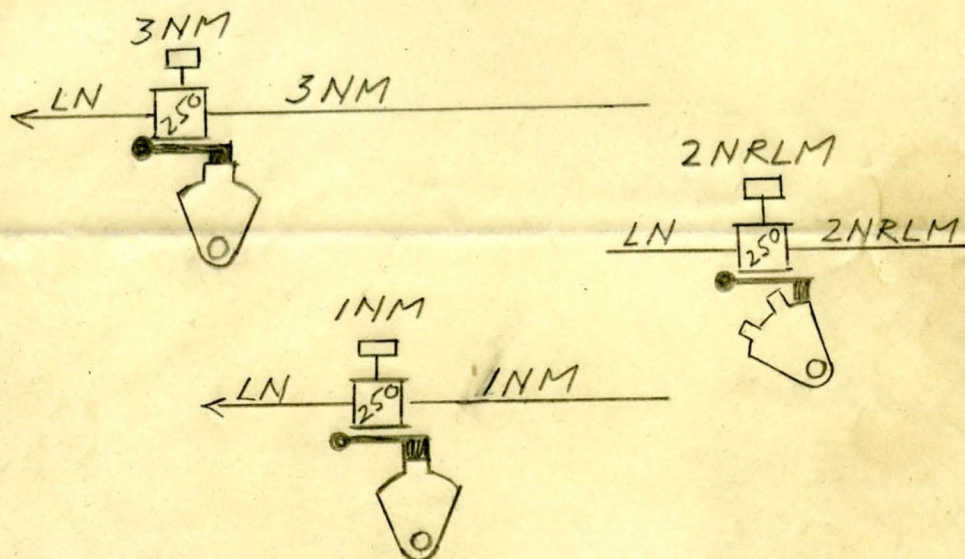
