





\*History of Shattuc Tower\*

O&M Railroad built a depot and station in 1898 at Shattuc Illinois, it was a two story building and the operator lived in the depot.

In April of 1924 a train while switching lost a boxcar and the box car crashed into the depot and completely destroyed it. O&M which was now the B&O RR, built this two story tower and never rebuilt the depot.

In this view looking North from Shattuc tower you can see signals 1 and 2. These signals were mechanical signals at one time but were replaced before 1954. The pipeline that can be seen to the right of the tracks controlled the signal. In this view the pipeline is abandoned.

In 1954 B&O removed the mechanical interlocking and converted it to electrical interlocking, during this they added the lower outer buildings. The north side of the tower held all the newly added relays, the west side of the tower was the newly added Ticket Agency.


-Sept 13 1954 - Signals 1 & 2 rewired in steel case by Division.

-Nov 21, 1958 - Interlocked derails 6,8, & 12 Removed. Mechanical Signals 13 &14 made Searchlight (SL) type.

In 1985 CSX removes the south interchange track with the BN and moves the siding switch back west. Illinois straightens out the highway.

In 1988 Shattuc Tower is Closed.








## Shattuc Dog Chart Improved S&F Mechanical Interlocking Machine








